Re: Parent and Carer Surveys

You may recall that during the last academic year **31 families out of 74** completed a survey in order to share their views of Forncett School with us. We were delighted to receive so many positive responses, with 100% of respondents saying that they would recommend Forncett School to a friend; a view also reinforced recently through the Parent View website. The results were as follows:

My Child is happy at this school

77% strongly agreed, and 23% agreed

Recent Parent View result – 95% strongly agree, 5% agree

My Child feels safe at the school

84% strongly agreed, and 16% agreed

Recent Parent View result – 85% strongly agree, 15% agree

My child is making good progress at this school

63% strongly agreed, 37% agreed

Recent Parent View result – 55% strongly agree, 45% agree

My child is well looked after at this school

84% strongly agreed, 16% agreed

Recent Parent View result – 80% strongly agree, 20% agree

My child is taught well at this school

71% strongly agreed, 29% agreed

Recent Parent View result – 60% strongly agree, 35% agree, 5% don't know

The school is well led and managed

81% strongly agreed, 19% agreed

Recent Parent View result – 85% strongly agree, 15% agree

This school responds well to any concerns I raise

77% strongly agreed, 23% agreed

Recent Parent View result – 70% strongly agree, 15% agree, 15% don't know

The school keeps me well informed about what goes on

74% strongly agreed, 26% agreed

(This question is not asked on Parent View)

The schools inclusive Christian values and ethos have a positive effect

71% strongly agreed, 23% agreed, and 6% disagreed

(This question is not asked on Parent View)

The school makes sure it's pupils are well behaved

63% strongly agreed, 30% agreed, and 7% disagreed

Recent Parent View result – 60% strongly agree, 35% agree, 5% don't know

The school deals effectively with bullying

67% strongly agree, 21% agreed, 8% disagree, 4% didn't know

Recent Parent View result – 55% strongly agree, 30% agree, 5% disagree, 10% don't know

My child receives appropriate homework for their age

57% strongly agreed, 33% agreed, 10% disagreed.

Recent Parent View result – 40% strongly agree, 20% agree, 30% disagree, 10% don't know

I receive valuable information about my child's progress

57% strongly agreed, 30% agreed, and 13% disagreed.

Recent Parent View result – 55% strongly agree, 40% agree, 5% disagree

Where parents/carers have disagreed with the statements above, the Head Teacher and Governors have taken steps to address these concerns.

Again, the response so far has been overwhelmingly positive although in both cases (Parent Survey and Parent View), a few parents have indicated to us that they would like greater clarity regarding their child's progress at school or have raised concerns about the appropriate level of homework (some say too much and some too little). As a result of this feedback, Governors will be reviewing what may be done to address this.

All feedback is discussed at Governor Meetings in order for us to take any concerns seriously and shape future planning for the school. We value the views of our whole school community and wish to thank everybody for taking part.
